BHS MUSIC DEPT. TRIP 2024 GUIDELINES AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS

The following list of guidelines is to be respected by all those participating in the trip from May 15 to May 20, 2024. They are in place simply to prevent any misunderstandings between students and chaperones. Students are asked to read them carefully and sign at the bottom to signify their agreement that they shall adhere to the following guidelines.

1. **Drinking of alcoholic beverages, the use of non-prescription drugs, vaping, and smoking is prohibited at any time during the trip and will be dealt with severely if encountered.**
2. Visitation between male and female hotel rooms is permitted however, doors **must** be left open and there is to be no laying on beds together.
3. No student shall be permitted to leave their group without specific permission from their chaperone.
4. **Students are asked to always be with at least one other person or in groups during explorations of NYC. They are required to check in frequently with designated chaperones during these times.**
5. We would ask that students NOT visit with friends and/or relatives during any part of the trip. Friends or relatives are welcome to come to where we are and visit with you but you will not be permitted to leave the group.
6. Curfews are in place to ensure that students (and chaperones) obtain required rest and sleep.
7. Chaperones are on the trip as guides and helpers. For the purposes of the trip, they are much like your parents and should be respected as such. Therefore, if you are asked to do something by a chaperone, please be as cooperative as possible.
8. If room cards are lost, a replacement will have to be requested from the hotel front desk.
9. **Please respect all times on the schedule and do not be late meeting the group.**
10. Students are to be polite and respectful of roommates, other guests in the hotel, and while in public during our trip.

Infractions of the above guidelines will be dealt with accordingly at the discretion of the lead teacher, chaperones, your individual parents, and school administration.
